Each of the undersigned being duly aware of the risks and hazards inherent upon entering said premises and/or enroute to or from the same and/or in participating in any activities held at said premises, hereby voluntarily elects to enter upon said premises and/or participate in such activities, knowing the present condition and intended use of said premises and knowing that said condition and/or use may become more hazardous and dangerous during the time that each of the undersigned is upon the said premises.
